

The James E. French Memorial Scholarship Scholarship Guidelines

1. Applicants must be enrolled in either Carpentry I, Carpentry II or Welding I at the Ashtabula County Technical & Career Center. Applicants must be from Ashtabula County.
2. Scholarships will be for a one-year period.
3. Two awards in the amount of \$200.00 each will be awarded annually to the following for tools and fees:

One student enrolled in Carpentry I OR
One student enrolled in Carpentry II OR
One student enrolled in Welding I

(Note: Both awards can be in Carpentry or one in each Carpentry and Welding, as the selection committee may deem appropriate.)

4. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** A complete application will include all of the following:
 - (1) A one page essay, typed and double spaced that addresses these questions:
 - Why did you choose to pursue this career-tech program?
 - What are your long-term career goals and objectives?
 - How will this scholarship benefit you?
 - (2) This two-page application completed by you.
 - (3) A transcript of **all** credits earned in high school. Copies will be accepted.
 - (4) Two letters of recommendation stating your qualifications. One must be from a high school instructor. The other may be from any person who knows you well.
5. Applicants are to submit the application packet in a sealed envelope with the applicant's name written on the outside.
6. **Applications must be received by Mr. Wludyga by May 1st for consideration for the scholarship. No late applications will be considered.** The information asked for in this application is necessary in order for us to determine the award winners. Please submit your application packet to:
