 - This two-page application completed by you.
 - (3) A transcript of **all** credits earned in high school. Copies will be accepted.
 - (4) Two letters of recommendation stating your qualifications. One must be from a high school instructor. The other may be from any person who knows you well.
- 5. Applicants are to submit the application packet in a sealed envelope with the applicant's name written on the outside.
- 6. Applications must be <u>received</u> by Mr. Wludyga by May 1st for consideration for the scholarship. <u>No late applications will be</u> <u>considered</u>.
