

**The 2025 Gary A. Pratt Scholarship in honor of Gary A. Pratt
founder of the In-Country Vietnam Veterans - In-Country
Veterans**

This scholarship is for students planning to attend an accredited trade school in the fall. Two Scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be presented at the end of the school year. Applicants must have the forms in by May 1, 2025.

Eligibility for this scholarship is as follows, applicants must have an accredited trade school and be accepted for the fall semester. A family member must be a veteran of any of the armed services, Army, Navy, Air Force Marines and the Coast Guard. Family members include grandfather, grandmother, father, mother, brother and sister. Applicants must have proper documentation of service. DD-214. Honorable discharge from service. Or if on active-duty verification of status.

At least a five hundred (500) word essay that reflects your family member contributions to the armed services, what you are interested in and why you applied for this scholarship.

Checks will be sent to the accredited trade school of your choice.
