Other student eligibility include: students that attend JAHS through open enrollment but live outside the district; students that are homeschooled and reside within the JAHS district.

The Treasurer will pay out the scholarship to the recipient upon receipt of proof of successful completion of the first quarter, or semester of college/school.

Completed application must be postmarked or emailed on or before May 1, 2025. Please note that the delivery through the USPS cannot be controlled by the Rotary Club of Jefferson. Any applications received after May 8<sup>th</sup> will not be considered.
